1. **Tournament Venue** - UW-La Crosse Recreational Eagle Center (Courts 1-2)

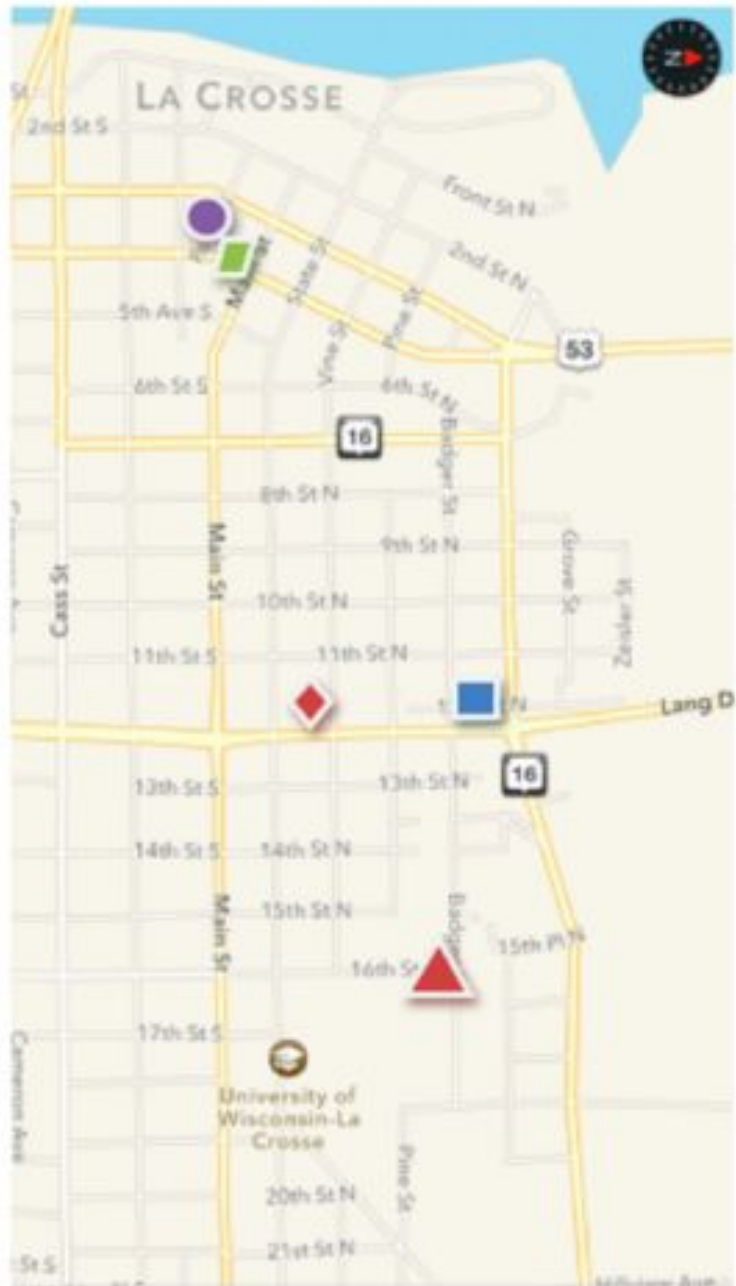

## Playing Rules Clarification

1. The “geographically closest” team is the home team for each match.
2. Warm-ups: 10 minutes - suggested 3 min ball handling, 6 min shared hitting, 1 min serving
3. Officiating - R1’s and R2’s will be provided for all playdate matches. Teams will provide 2 line judges and 2 scorekeepers for all pool play matches.
4. Pursuit rule is not in effect. Libero serving and 12 Substitutions will be used.
5. Jewellery rule from USAV states:

*For adult competition, jewelry may be worn provided its nature does not present a concern for safety, e.g., extremely long necklaces and/or necklaces with large medallions, or large hoop earrings.”*
