## WVC rolls out new divisional alignment for Men's Teams in 2017

In collaboration with team leaders, the WVC Advisory Board approved a new format for WVC teams this season. The guiding principles for the changes are to continue to recruit teams to join our league, create the most competitive schedules (versus teams at a similar level of competition) possible, and reduce travel for our teams. In formatting the divisions, the top 4 teams from last season were placed into Division 1, while the remaining 16 teams played a "qualifier" tournament the first weekend of February at UW-Oshkosh to determine their divisional placement. Congratulations to **UW-La Crosse** on winning the qualifier tournament! The Eagles were led by freshman middle blocker, Phil Weisbecker, who led the team in blocks and aces and setter Eric Heyrman who ran an efficient offense after making the switch from playing middle.
